




Subject to the approval of the Chief Judge and

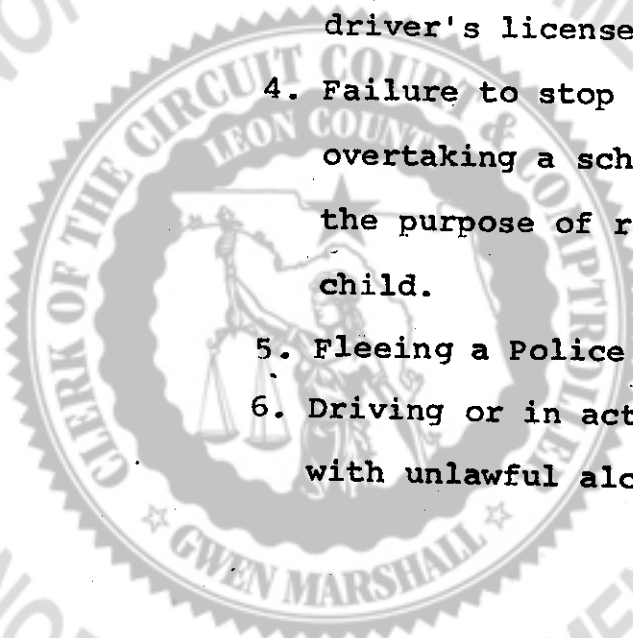

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #75-4


In any case filed within the Traffic Division of this Court wherein a Capias has been issued for the arrest of a defendant for failure to appear at the specified time, upon such Capias being outstanding for a period of thirty days and remaining unserved, it shall be withdrawn and the Division of Driver's License of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall be notified that the defendant has a matter pending before the Court and that the driver's license of the defendant should not be renewed until further advised by the Court except that in the following cases the Capias shall be outstanding six months during which diligent efforts will be made to locate the defendant and after which time upon the failure to serve it upon the defendant the Capias will be withdrawn and the Division of Driver's License notified of the defendants failure to meet his obligation to the Court. These latter offenses are:

1. Operation of or actual physical control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a narcotic or habit forming drug.
2. Leaving the scene of an accident.
3. Driving while under suspension or revocation of driver's license.
4. Failure to stop and remain standing upon meeting or overtaking a school bus stopped on the highway for the purpose of receiving or discharging a school child.
5. Fleeing a Police Officer.
6. Driving or in actual physical control of motor vehicle with unlawful alcohol content.



7. Incompetent driver.
