

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 75-13

O R D E R

Pursuant to Chapter 43-195, Florida Statutes, the Clerk of the County Court is hereby authorized to destroy any exhibits filed with the Court in excess of ten years in cases on which no appeal is pending or can be made. Items of evidence having no monetary value which are designated by the clerk for removal shall be disposed of as unusable refuse. Items of evidence having a monetary value which are designated for removal by the clerk shall be sold and the revenue placed in the clerk's general revenue fund.
