ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 76-2

In all cases filed in the County Judge's Court and transferred to the County Court under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Florida and cases filed since the beginning of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Florida wherein the defendant therein has not been arrested and three years have elapsed since the filing of the Complaint or Information or, if the defendant has been arrested and three years have elapsed with no prosecution taking place, it is hereby

ORDERED that the State Attorney shall, within 120 days of this Order, file within any such cause, reason for such cause to remain outstanding. Upon failure to file such reason or to otherwise show cause why dismissal is unwarranted, the Court shall enter its Order dismissing all such cases without prejudice. No less often than every 12 months, the Clerk of the County Court shall certify to the Court, with a copy to the State Attorney, all cases on file more than 3 years subsequent to filing of Complaint or Information.
