
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2

IN RE: Coroner's Inquest

IT HAS been brought to the Court's attention that in matters dealing with a Coroner's Inquest there appears to be no uniform policy with regard to the recordation and transcription of said proceedings. It is the feeling of the Court that in order to preserve the transcript of Coroner's Inquests in this Court it is in the best interest of justice that said proceedings be stenographically recorded by an official Court Reporter in and for the Second Judicial Circuit for Leon County.

WHEREFORE the Clerk is directed and authorized to make the proper and necessary arrangements for the transcription of any and all Coroner's Inquests conducted in this Court. The Clerk is further authorized to expend the necessary funds for cost involved in these types of proceedings.
