



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 78-10

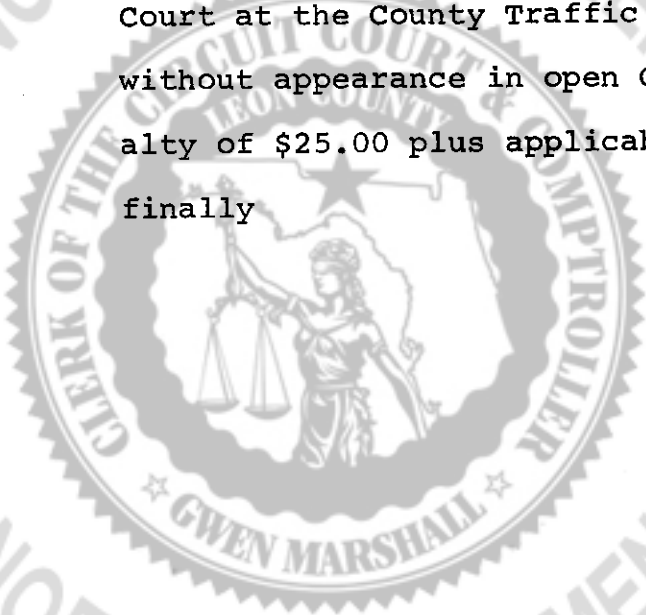
SUBJECT: SECTION 403.413, FLORIDA STATUTES
FLORIDA LITTER LAW.

The enactment of Chapter 78-202 Laws of Florida has been brought to the attention of this Court and after due consideration it is

ORDERED that any process issued charging a violation of this Law and alleging a littering of less than five pounds shall be returnable to the Traffic Violations Bureau and shall be treated by said Bureau in the same manner as a Civil Traffic Infraction under the procedures of Chapter 318, Florida Statutes. It is further

ORDERED that any process charging a violation and alleging littering of a total weight of five pounds or more shall be returnable to the Clerk of the County Court, Leon County Courthouse to be handled and processed as a second degree misdemeanor. It is further


ORDERED that any violation alleging litter of a total weight of less than five pounds may, upon the plea of guilty or no contest entered by a Defendant appearing before the Clerk of the Court at the County Traffic Violations Bureau be disposed of without appearance in open Court by the payment of a civil penalty of \$25.00 plus applicable surcharges, if any. It is finally

ORDERED that any first offense violation of this Statute alleging litter of a total weight of five pounds or more may be dismissed upon appearance of the Defendant at the office of the Clerk of the County Court, Criminal Division, Leon County Courthouse, the entry of a plea of guilty or no contest, and the payment of costs of \$35.00; except that if the arresting officer shall deem it to be an aggravated violation and shall file with the Clerk a statement of facts supporting such belief along with the arrest citation then a personal appearance in open Court shall be required of the Defendant. A personal appearance shall be necessary for any second or subsequent offense.
