

become effective immediately upon adoption.

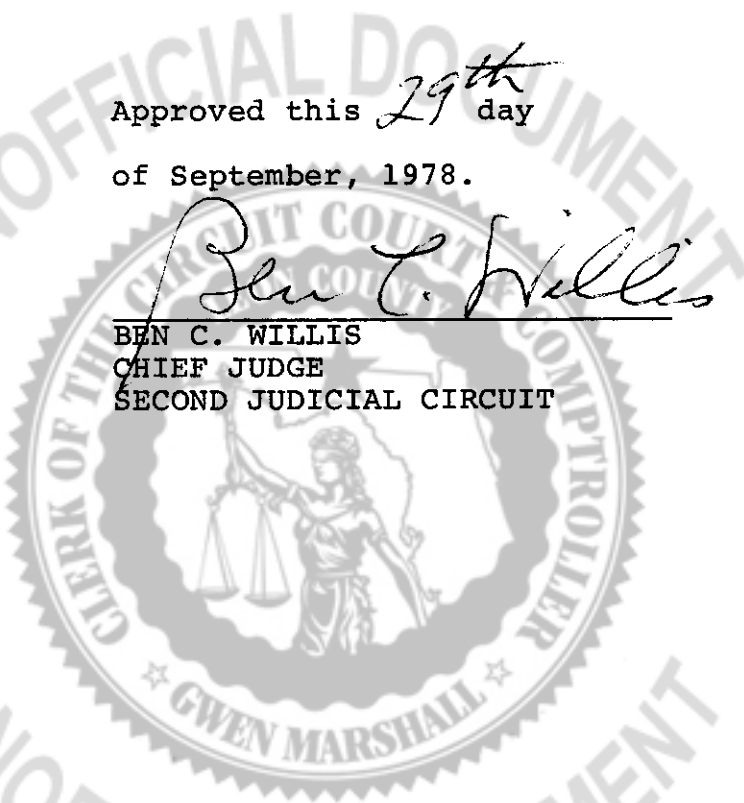

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 11

RE: Juvenile Traffic Offenses

I. BEGINNING October 1, 1978, and pursuant to Chapter 78-414, Laws of Florida, 1978, the following Juvenile Traffic Offenses shall be transferred from the County Court of Leon County to the Circuit Court in and for the Second Judicial Circuit in that said offenses have been defined in Chapter 316.630 as Juvenile Delinquent Acts:

A. Fleeing or attempting to elude a law enforcement officer or failing or refusing to comply with any lawful order or direction by any police officer or member of the fire department in violation of Section 316.072 sub. para. 3.

B. Leaving the scene of a collision or an accident involving death or personal injuries or with an unattended vehicle. sub. para. 3.

C. Driving while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, narcotic drugs, barbituates, or other stimulants in violation of Section 316.193.


D. Driving without a restricted operators license if under the age of sixteen.

E. Driving without a valid operators license or while the license is suspended or revoked.

II. Pursuant to Section 316.630(5), Florida Statutes, as amended by Section 21, Chapter 78-414, Laws of Florida, any traffic offense by a child which is adjudged an act of delinquency or the child has previously been found guilty of two or more traffic offenses within six months and the evidence indicates the advisability of Circuit Court jurisdiction, shall be the subject of a special order by a Judge of the County Court making such finding and directing the transfer to the Circuit Court.

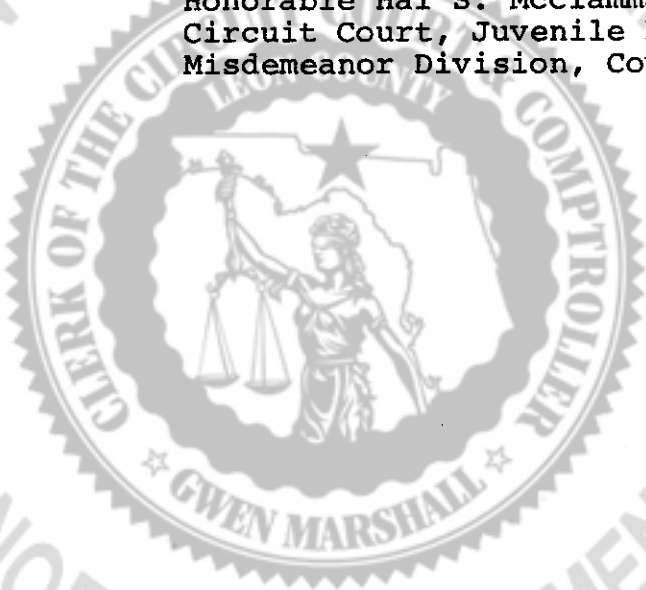
III. All Traffic Infractions shall be maintained in the County Court in and for Leon County unless otherwise directed by the Court.
