ORDER

The attached Bond Schedule may be used by the Sheriff of Leon County where an accused is being held in custody immediately following arrest and has not had a First Appearance before a judicial officer.

Any Defendant has the right to a First Appearance hearing on the question of bail and its amount.

Any arresting officer may, by application in writing, request that an accused be required to appear before a judicial officer at First Appearance hearing in lieu of posting bail under this schedule.

It is the intent of this Order that any accused not wishing to wait for a First Appearance hearing may post bond according to this schedule unless the arresting officer requests in writing that the accused be held for a First Appearance hearing.

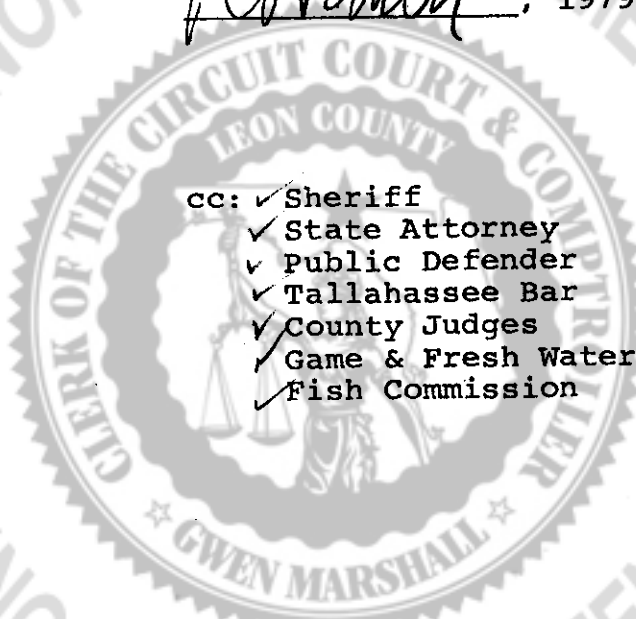

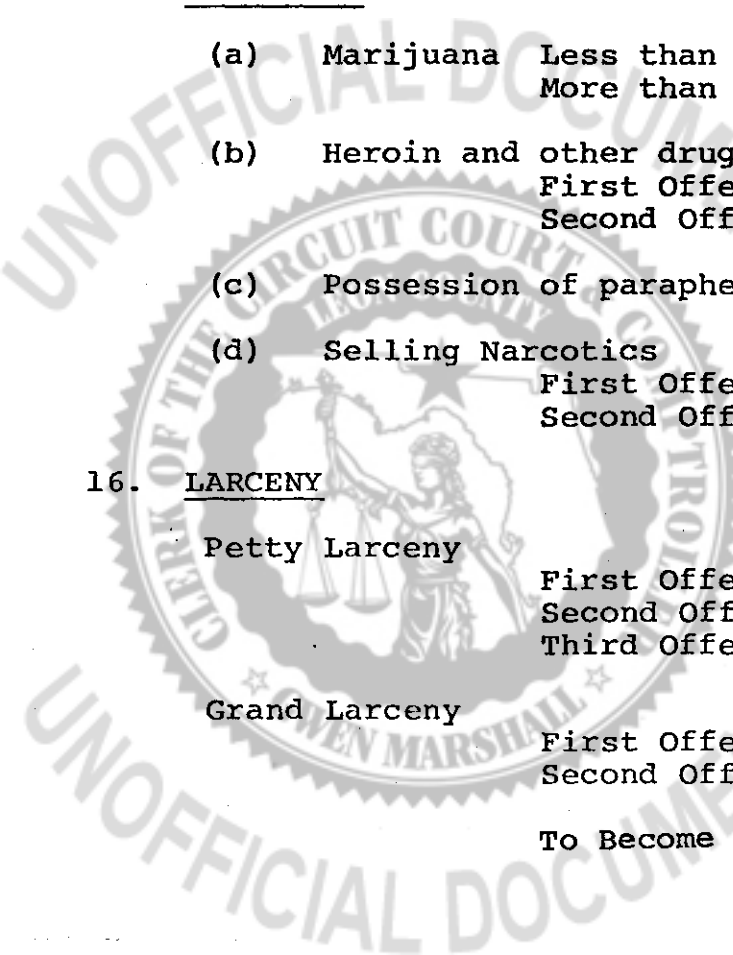
