ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 80-1

Each Judge of this Court shall be assigned a Jury Trial date at random in such a manner that each Judge is assigned approximately the same number of Trial days for each annual period.

The State Attorney shall assign cases for Trial on each Trial day so that the case load for each day shall be as even as is reasonably possible, worthless check day excepted.

After a case is assigned to a Trial date the Clerk is then authorized to disclose to interested parties the name of the Judge assigned to that date.

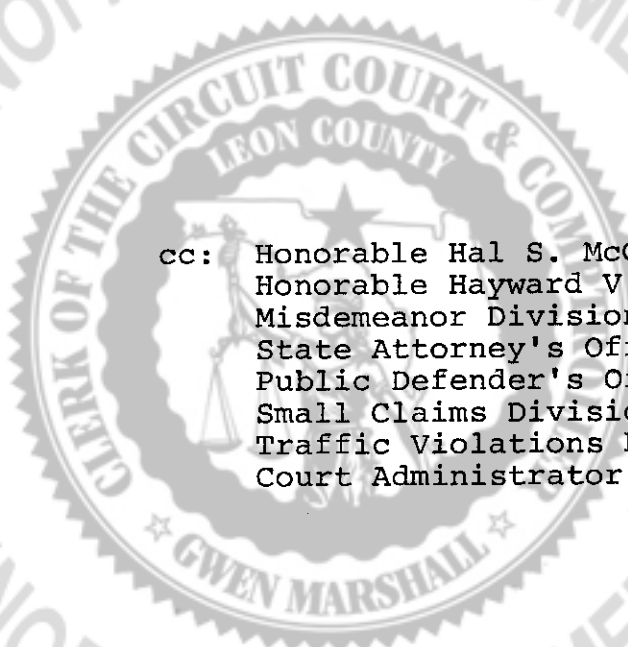
All matters relating to the case so assigned shall be heard by the Judge assigned its Trial date and all continuances shall be made to the assigned Judge. There shall be no exceptions to this Order without leave of Court.

This Order shall apply to all Misdemeanor cases filed in County and shall be inapplicable to the Civil and Traffic Divisions, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
