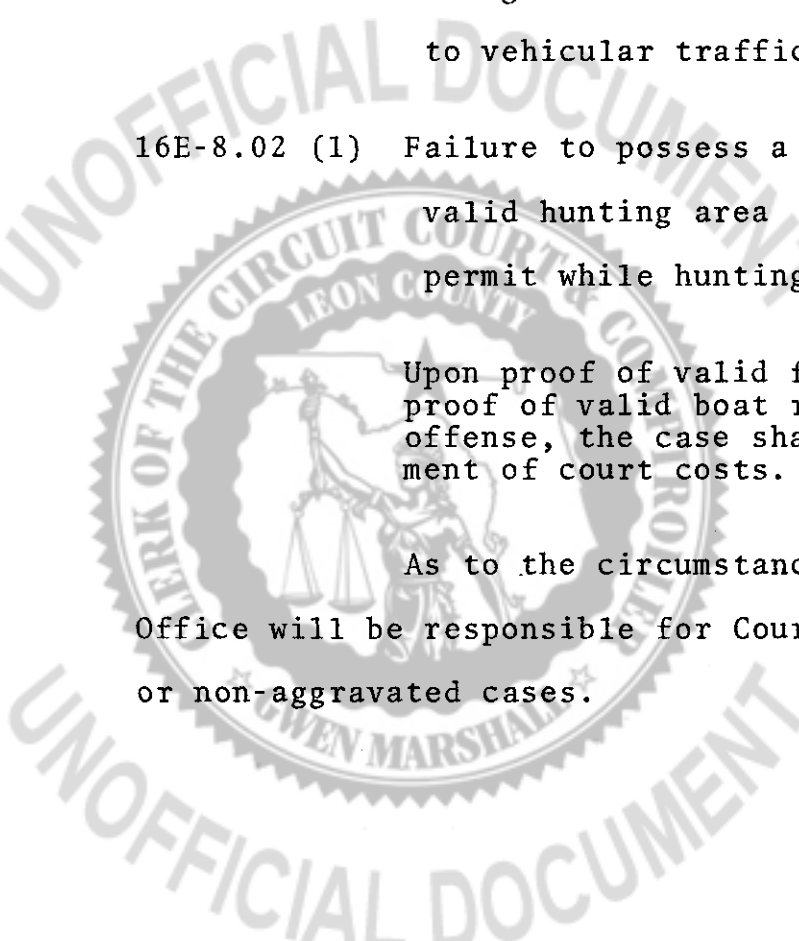
TO THE CLERK OF THE COUNTY COURT:

Upon the express recommendation of the State Attorney's Office, you are hereby authorized to dismiss the following types of cases:

Upon proof of valid fishing or hunting license, or proof of valid boat registration at the time of the offense, the case shall be dismissed without assessment of court costs.

As to the circumstances category, the State Attorney's Office will be responsible for Court file notations as to aggravated or non-aggravated cases.
