



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO.10

IT HAS been brought to the attention of the Court  
by the local Bar Association and the citizenry in general that  
difficulty has been experienced by the setting of all civil cases  
to come up at pre-trial at the same time whether the parties  
represented by attorneys or not. In the future the Court is  
directed to set all matters dealing with claims under fifteen  
hundred dollars (\$1500.) at pre-trial hearings in County Court  
to begin at 9:30 A.M. for those cases where there are no attorneys  
of record on either side at the time of filing. On all cases  
where there is an attorney of record in the case at the time  
of filing those cases shall be set at pre-trial at 10:30 A.M.,  
on the same date.
