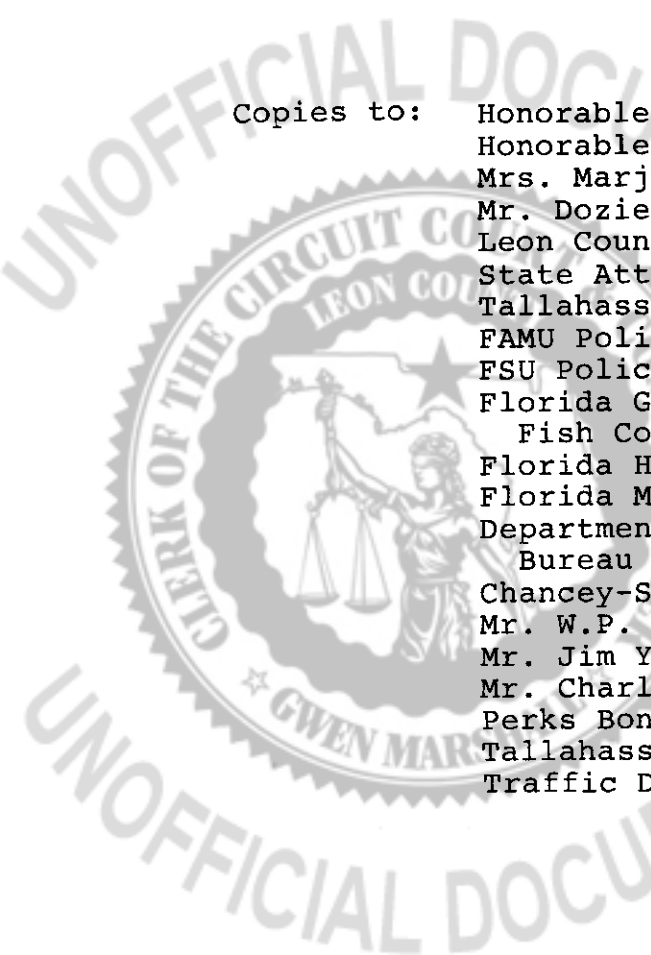
Such evidence may be an auto repair bill or a parts invoice and the affidavit of Defendant that repairs are accomplished.
