1. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of some controlled substances under Chapter 893, Florida Statutes, in the legal possession of the Tallahassee (Florida) Police Department, Vice and Intelligence Section.
2. The memorandum of the Supervisor of the Vice and Intelligence Section states that the materials are to be used as "drug display material(s)" and when not in use for such purposes will be stored in the main office of the Vice and Intelligence Section of the said Department.
3. That so long as the required records of the listed substances are kept, pursuant to Section 893, Florida Statutes, and maintained under control of the said Department at all times so as to avoid these substances falling into the hands of unauthorized persons, the same may be used for drug abuse prevention instructional purposes, and when no longer used shall be disposed of according to law.

This display case was constructed in 1968 and is in need of revision and re-stocking. Some of the material has deteriorated due to age and needs to be replaced.
