ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2007-07

IN RE: UNCLAIMED FUNDS PAID INTO COURT REGISTRY

WHEREAS, 43.19, Florida Statutes, requires that moneys deposited for five years or more, remaining unclaimed by any person, firm or corporation entitled thereto, be deposited with the Chief Financial Officer to the credit of the State School Fund to become a part of that fund, subject only to the right of the person, firm or corporation to petition and prove entitlement to the fund; and


WHEREAS, that the attached list compiled by the Leon County Clerk of Court as of November 31, 2007, contains a list of cases to which deposits have been made into the Court Registry; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Court reports that there has been no activity involving these moneys deposited for five years prior to November 31, 2007, and the funds remain outstanding in the Court Registry; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the funds is \$223,301.38; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Leon County Clerk of Court is directed to distribute the total amount of \$223,301.38 to the Chief Financial Officer to the credit of the State School Fund.
