**WHEREAS**, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore


**ORDERED** that:

Section II, A., of Administrative Order No. 2008-15 is amended to read as follows:

**II GADSDEN COUNTY**

A. Circuit Judge Kathleen F. Dekker shall be assigned all circuit criminal cases, juvenile delinquency, and criminal appeals from County Court, by assuming the criminal caseload previously assigned to Circuit Judge Thomas Bateman III, including all previously scheduled hearing and trial dates and times associated therewith.
