**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2010-06  
SECOND AMENDMENT**

**IN RE: COMPREHENSIVE COURT ENFORCEMENT FOR THE UNIFORM  
COLLECTION OF COURT ORDERED PAYMENTS OF FINES, COURT  
COSTS AND OTHER DISPOSITIONAL ASSESSMENTS IN LEON COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order 2010-06 provided comprehensive procedures for the collection of court costs, fines and other dispositional assessments; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of budgetary limitations in the office of the Clerk of Circuit Court in and for Leon County, Florida, the Court has been advised that the clerk does not have available resources to comply with the procedures required pursuant to the administrative order; and


**WHEREAS**, without implementation of the procedures required pursuant Administrative Order 2010-06, as amended, substantial due process issues may be implicated.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

1. Administrative Order 2010-06, as amended, shall terminate as of the completion of collections court scheduled for December 21, 2010.
2. No further cases shall be scheduled for the collections court after December 21, 2010.
3. All outstanding blue writs issued as the result of the defendant being in arrears on scheduled payments for criminal court costs, fines, or fees are hereby withdrawn, effective immediately.
4. Nothing contained herein shall in any way restrict or prohibit the Clerk from performing his statutory duties in connection with the collection of criminal court costs, fines or fees, nor prevent the Clerk from pursuing all statutory remedies available to him for such purposes.
