**IN RE: SUSPENSION OF MANDATORY REFERRAL OF MORTGAGE
FORECLOSURE CASES INVOLVING HOMESTEAD RESIDENCES TO
MEDIATION FOR CASES FILED SUBSEQUENT TO DECEMBER 20, 2011.**

Whereas, The Supreme Court of the State of Florida has entered AOSC-11-44 which, *inter alia*, terminated the statewide managed mediation program, and


Whereas, A0-2010-05 of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida implemented the managed mediation program in the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida, and

Whereas, it is necessary to suspend AO 2010-05 in order to comply with AOSC-11-44,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Administrative Order 2010-05 of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida is hereby suspended until further order of this Court as it applies to new Mortgage Foreclosure case filings occurring subsequent to December 20, 2011.
2. The Clerks of Court of the Counties comprising the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida are relieved of the responsibility of providing the Program Manager with access to the clerk's file in each new residential mortgage foreclosure action.
3. All cases which were subject to AO 2010-05 which were filed on or before December 20, 2011 shall continue to be subject to the requirements of that order until further order of this Court.
4. This Order shall be effective immediately.
