**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2010 - 10
THIRD AMENDMENT**

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2010-10, as amended, currently sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215 (b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the judicial assignments set forth in Administrative Order 2010-10, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows:

1. Item 1.A. is amended to read as follows:

1. **LEON COUNTY**

- A. **Circuit Court Criminal Division**

- Circuit Judges Charles A. Francis, James C. Hankinson, Charles W. Dodson, Angela C. Dempsey and Mark E. Walker shall be assigned to the Criminal Division and assigned all cases as follows:

3. **Circuit Judge Mark E. Walker, Division C.**

- Division C shall be assigned one-third of all criminal cases not assigned to Division D and E. Judge Walker shall assume the caseload previously assigned to Judge Josefina M. Tamayo, including all pending and previously scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.

2. Item 1.C. is amended to read as follows:

1. **LEON COUNTY**

- C. **Family Division.**

- Circuit Judges George S. Reynolds, III, Dawn Caloca-Johnson, Josefina M. Tamayo, Karen A. Gievers and Frank E. Sheffield shall be assigned to the Family Division and assigned all family law cases.

The Family Division shall include the following category of cases: dissolution of marriage, division and distribution of property arising out of dissolution of marriage, annulment, support unconnected to dissolution of marriage, paternity, child support, URESA/UIFSA, custodial care of and access to children, adoption, name change, declaratory judgment actions related to premarital, marital and postmarital agreements, civil domestic violence and repeat violence injunctions, juvenile dependency and delinquency, and termination of parental rights. These cases, together with all pending and previously scheduled hearings, trial dates and times associated therewith, shall be assigned as follows:

- 2. Circuit Judge Josefina M. Tamayo.

40% of all Family Division cases, excepting juvenile delinquency and dependency, domestic violence and repeat violence cases; 11.1% of the domestic violence and repeat violence case; and an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge. Judge Tamayo shall assume the caseload previously assigned to Judge Mark E. Walker, including all pending and previously scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.

- 3. This order shall be effectively January 23, 2012, and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
- 4. Except as expressly amended or modified herein, all of the terms and provisions of Administrative Order 2010-10, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
