**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-05
SECOND AMENDMENT**

IN RE: CIRCUIT JUDGE AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2014-05, In Re: Circuit Judge and County Judge Assignments, as amended, currently sets forth assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the chief judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions, and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

ORDERED that effective March 30, 2015, Sections I.E., I.E.4., I.G., and I.G.4 of Administrative Order 2014-05, First Amendment, are amended to read as follows:

E. Leon County Court Criminal Division.

County Judges Augustus D. Aikens, Jr., Nina Ashenafi Richardson, Ronald W. Flury, J. Layne Smith, and Robert R. Wheeler shall be assigned to the County Court Criminal Division which shall include all pending and previously scheduled hearing and trial dates and times associated therewith, as follows:

4. County Judge J. Layne Smith.

Twenty percent (20%) of all criminal cases.

G. Leon County Court Civil Division.

County Judges Augustus D. Aikens, Jr., Nina Ashenafi Richardson, Ronald W. Flury, J. Layne Smith, and Robert R. Wheeler shall be assigned to the County Court Civil Division which shall include all pending and previously scheduled hearing and trial dates and times associated therewith, as follows:

4. County Judge J. Layne Smith.

Twenty percent (20%) of all civil cases.
