**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-05
THIRD AMEMDMENT**

IN RE: CIRCUIT JUDGE AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2014-05, In Re: Circuit Judge and County Judge Assignments, as amended, currently sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

ORDERED that effective July 1, 2015, Sections I.A., I.A.6., I.B., I.B.2., I.C.2., I.C.4., and I.C.5. of Administrative Order 2014-05, Second Amendment, are amended to read as follows:

A. Circuit Court Criminal Division.

Circuit Judges Terry P. Lewis, Frank E. Sheffield, James O. Shelfer, Kevin J. Carroll and Jonathan Sjostrom shall be assigned to the Criminal Division and assigned all cases as follows:

6. Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom, Misdemeanor Appeals.

All misdemeanor appeals from county court are assigned to Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom.

B. Circuit Civil Division.

Circuit Judges George S. Reynolds, III, James C. Hankinson, Angela Dempsey and Charles W. Dodson shall be assigned to the Civil Division and assigned all civil cases, prisoner petitions, and civil appeals from county court, excluding Probate and Family Law Division Cases as follows:

2. Circuit Judge Charles W. Dodson.

Sixteen percent (16%) of all civil cases and sixteen percent (16%) of all civil prisoner petitions by assuming the case load previously assigned to Chief Judge Charles A. Francis, including all pending and scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.



C. Family Division.

2. Division B: Circuit Judge Charles W. Dodson.

All juvenile delinquency cases; and an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge. Division B shall not be assigned matters under Chapter 39, including juvenile dependency and termination of parental rights cases, except as otherwise ordered by the Chief Judge.


4. Division D: Chief Judge Charles A. Francis.

Forty (40%) of all Family Division cases including all civil injunctions (related to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking), as well as an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge, excepting juvenile delinquency, juvenile dependency, and termination of parental rights cases by assuming the case load previously assigned to Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom, including all pending and scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.

5. Division E: Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom.

Twenty (20%) of all Family Division cases including all civil injunctions (related to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking), as well as an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge, excepting juvenile delinquency, juvenile dependency, and termination of parental rights cases by assuming the case load previously assigned to Circuit Judge Charles W. Dodson, including all pending and scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.
