**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-05
FOURTH AMENDMENT**

IN RE: CIRCUIT JUDGE AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2014-05, In Re: Circuit Judge and County Judge Assignments, as amended, currently sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

ORDERED that effective July 1, 2015, Sections, I.C.3., I.C.4., I.C.5. and I.C.6. of Administrative Order 2014-05, Third Amendment, are amended to read as follows:

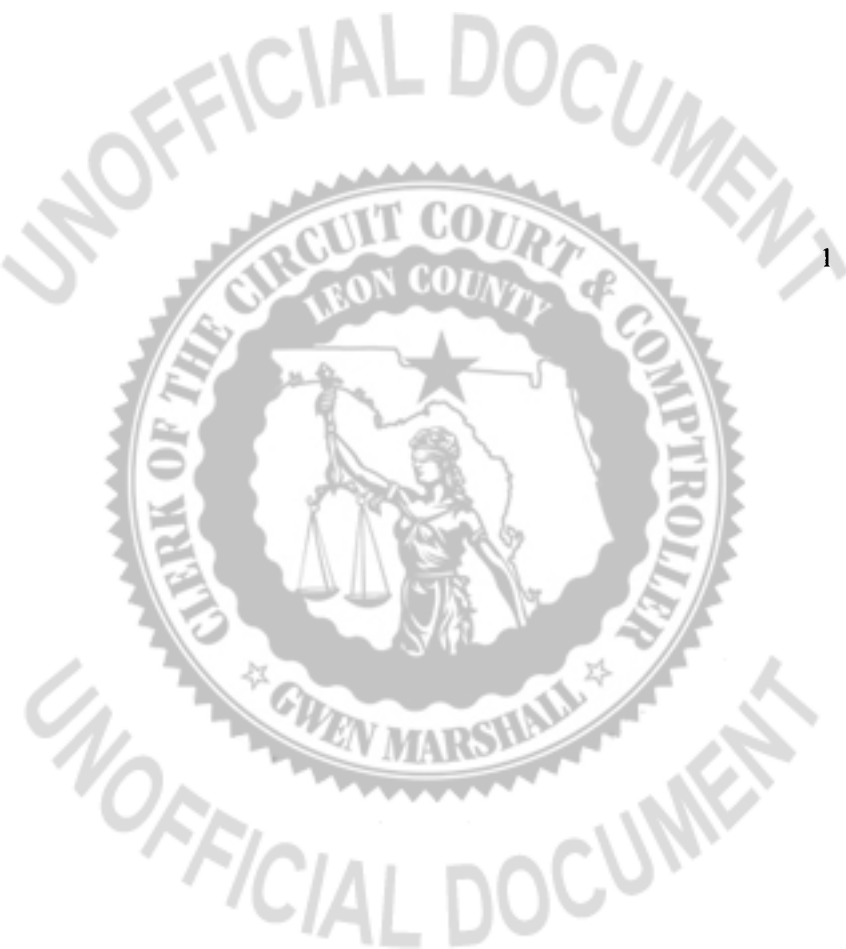
C. Family Division.

3. Division C: Circuit Judge John C. Cooper.

Forty (40%) of all Family Division cases, excluding all civil injunctions (related to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking), as well as an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge, excepting juvenile delinquency, juvenile dependency, and termination of parental rights cases.

4. Division D: Chief Judge Charles A. Francis.

Forty (40%) of all Family Division cases, excluding all civil injunctions (related to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking), as well as an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge, excepting juvenile delinquency, juvenile dependency, and termination of parental rights cases, by assuming the case load previously assigned to Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom, including all pending and scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.




5. Division E: Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom.

Twenty (20%) of all Family Division cases, excluding all civil injunctions (related to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking), as well as an equal rotation as Family Division duty judge, excepting juvenile delinquency, juvenile dependency, and termination of parental rights cases, by assuming the case load previously assigned to Circuit Judge Charles W. Dodson, including all pending and scheduled hearing and trial dates, and times associated therewith.

6. Division F: Civil Injunctions.

Chief Judge Charles A. Francis, Chief Judge-Elect Jonathan Sjostrom, and Circuit Judges John C. Cooper and Karen Gievers are assigned to the Civil Injunctions Division. Civil injunctions include matters related to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking. All Civil Injunctions shall be assigned on a rotational basis as determined and assigned by the Administrative Judge of the Family Division.
