IN RE: CIRCUIT AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2015-085, In Re: Circuit and County Judge Assignments, currently sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

ORDERED that effective February 22, 2016, Sections I.D.1 and II.A. of Administrative Order 2015-08 are amended to read as follows:

I. LEON COUNTY.


D. Probate Division.

1. General Probate Cases. Circuit Judge Francis J. Allman shall be assigned all probate cases, except Baker Act and Marchman Act.

II. FRANKLIN COUNTY.

A. Circuit Judge Francis J. Allman shall be assigned all circuit criminal cases, civil cases, family cases, including juvenile delinquency and dependency cases, probate cases, and all appeals from county court.
