**WHEREAS**, section 61.21, Florida Statutes, requires all parties to a dissolution of marriage proceeding with minor children or a paternity action that involves issues of parental responsibility shall be required to complete the Parent Education and Family Stabilization Course prior to entry by the court of a final judgment, and


**WHEREAS**, section 61.21, Florida Statutes, provides that the court may excuse a party from attending the parenting course, or from completing the course within the required time, for good cause and,

**WHEREAS**, section 61.21, Florida Statutes, requires the Department of Children and Families to provide each judicial circuit with a list of approved Parent Education and Family Stabilization Course providers, it is therefore

**ORDERED** that:

Administrative Order 1992-08, In Re: Approved Parenting Class, and all amendments, is hereby terminated.
