**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2017-07**

**IN RE: DRIVER LICENSE CLINIC**

**WHEREAS**, many residents of Leon County cannot legally drive because their driver license has been suspended or revoked as required by law;

**WHEREAS**, functioning in modern society is facilitated by access to transportation;

**WHEREAS**, many residents who have lost their driving privilege do not know what they have to do to become eligible to legally drive again; and


**WHEREAS**, the multi-agency Leon County Driver License Clinic will assist residents in identifying the steps necessary to reinstate suspended or revoked driving privileges; it is therefore

**ORDERED** that:

Leon County Judge Stephen Everett and Leon County Judge J. Layne Smith are temporarily assigned limited jurisdiction over the following cases appearing before them at the Driver License Clinic on July 7, 2017 and October 13, 2017:

1. all Second Judicial Circuit county court cases; and
2. all Second Judicial Circuit felony cases solely as permitted by law as to court costs and fines affecting driver licenses, but specifically excluding restitution.
