
**SECOND NO TRUE BILL PRESENTMENT**

THIS MATTER came before the Grand Jury for us to review the facts and circumstances of the shooting death of Genie McMeans, Jr. on May 9, 2002 by Florida Highway Patrol Trooper Kreshawn Walker-Vergenz along Interstate 10 between Miccosukee Road and Centerville Road in Leon County, Florida.

A detailed investigation by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement was reviewed by this Grand Jury on July 23, 2002 and we received sworn testimony from a variety of material witnesses including Saul Ticona, an eyewitness who was the decedent's friend driving his car that morning, and Trooper Walker-Vergenz. After deliberations evaluating the totality of the facts and circumstances, fewer than 12 jurors found sufficient evidence to support a criminal homicide charge which means a No True Bill.

On this date we reconvened to review a more detailed analysis of certain physical evidence such as bullet trajectory and the location of the spent cartridge casings in relation to the motor vehicles to further evaluate possible positions of Genie McMeans, Jr. and the Trooper when the first shot was fired. After further deliberations fewer than 12 jurors find the evidence sufficient to support a criminal charge and file this Second No True Bill Presentment.
