THIS MATTER came before the Grand Jury for us to review the facts and circumstances of the stabbing death of Paris Dinapoli on July 29, 2005 by Nicole Nero inside their residence located at 3700 SE Capital Circle, Apartment 710 in Tallahassee, Florida. The investigation by the Tallahassee Police Department concluded that this was a lawful homicide within the statutory provisions of Chapter 776, Florida Statutes, regarding justifiable use of deadly force and review by the Grand Jury was requested.

We have heard the sworn testimony of Nicole Nero and reviewed the investigation by the Tallahassee Police Department, and agree that the evidence supports a reasonable belief on the part of Nicole Nero that the use of deadly force was necessary to prevent imminent death or great bodily harm to himself or to prevent the imminent commission of a forcible felony.

THEREFORE, as fewer than 12 jurors find sufficient evidence to support a charge of murder or manslaughter, we file this No True Bill Presentment.
