3. Sealing of this Court file is necessary to avoid substantial injury to the subject of this action and, therefore, qualifies for sealing under Rule 2.420(9), Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin.
4. No persons other than the Petitioner, the subject of this action, and their counsel may view these records without court order.
5. The Court specifically finds that the (i) degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth

above; and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests of the subject of this litigation.

6. The Clerk of Court is directed to publish this order as may be required.

7. The Clerk of Court is ordered to seal all pleadings, documents, and orders under the above-styled case in compliance with this Order.
