**ORDER ON MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS
PURSUANT TO FLORIDA RULE OF JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.420(d)(1)(B)
(xii)**

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records filed by Jessica N. Daniels, Emergency Temporary Guardian Advocate of Ja'Kari Daniel Person, the Person with Developmental Disability, pursuant to rule 2.420(d)(1)(B)(xii), Florida Rule of Judicial Administration. Jessica N. Daniels seeks an order sealing the following information relative to this case: the address and contact information of Jessica N. Daniels, Ja'Kari Daniel Person and Paula Smith.

This motion is uncontested.

The Court GRANTS the motion as follows:

1. Jessica N. Daniels, the victim in a domestic violence action, has properly requested that her address and contact information be determined confidential for safety reasons.
2. Ja'Kari Daniel Person and Paula Smith share the same address.
3. The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect this/these interest(s), and the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect the interest(s).

WHEREFORE, it is ORDERED that:

the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall redact the address and contact information of Jessica N. Daniels, Ja'Kari Daniel Person and Paula Smith, kept in absolute confidence and shall not be disclosed to Jim H. Person, the Respondent in the domestic violence action. Further, the Clerk shall ensure that the address and contact information of Jessica N. Daniels, Ja'Kari Daniel Person and Paula Smith are redacted from all public materials in the file and that the final judgment is

recorded in a manner that does not reveal their address and contact information. However, the progress docket and the file shall otherwise remain available to the public.

It is further ORDERED that any materials sealed pursuant to this Order shall be conditionally disclosed upon the entry of a further order by this Court finding that such opening is necessary for purposes of judicial or governmental accountability or First Amendment rights.


It is further ORDERED that any materials sealed pursuant to this Order may otherwise be disclosed only as follows:

1. to any judge of this Circuit for case-related reasons;
2. to the Chief Judge or his or her designee;
3. to adult parties or their attorneys of record, with the exception of Jim H. Person; or
4. by further order of the Court.

It is further ORDERED that, within 10 days of the date of this Order, the Clerk shall post a copy of this Order on the bulletin board of the Leon County Clerk's Office and the Clerk's website for a period of 30 days to provide public notice.

It is further ORDERED that the Clerk is hereby authorized to unseal any materials sealed pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The materials shall be resealed immediately upon completion of the filing.
